We are happy to report our school transmission continues to remain LOW!

We are continuing to do our very best to be as proactive as possible when it comes to COVID-19 mitigation measures. Staff will be offered the 2nd vaccine on Tuesday, February 16th. The majority of those who have received the 2nd dose have done so with very few side effects. However, there have been few reports of side effects that last 24 hours post vaccine. While we anticipate our staff will fall in the majority of those with no concerns, we are doing our best to be proactive. As a way to allow staffing flexibility, and provide the least disruption to our learning environments, we will provide remote learning to high school students the day following our vaccine clinic.

High School students (grades 9-12) will receive remote instruction on Wednesday, February 17th.

For families with students PreK-8th grade, nothing will be different than scheduled. High school students attending Whiteside Area Career Center will attend this program as scheduled and will be remote for the remainder of the school day. All other high school students in grades 9-12 will receive remote instruction for the full day. Teachers will communicate login information with high school students prior to this date.

FJSHS before and after school activities will continue as normal, however please remember students must be present during remote learning in order to participate in after school activities. Attendance for high school students will be taken each hour via zoom, so please be sure your student is actively participating.
