Dear Forrestville Valley Families,

The goal of Forrestville Valley School District is to offer in-person instruction as long as our data suggests it is safe to do so. With community transmissions of COVID-19 on the rise, we want to be proactive in sharing an overview of our plan should remote learning become necessary. The information provided is to assist you with a general overview only. More detailed information, including specific daily schedules for each grade level, will be communicated if remote learning becomes necessary.

Forrestville Valley Remote Learning Plan is dependent on technology AND internet access. If you currently do not have internet access, please contact your building office <u>as soon as possible</u> to create an alternative plan.

All students will receive district issued technology devices to use during remote learning.

- Secondary students will continue to utilize a district issued Chromebook
- Elementary students will each be issued a district iPad

All students will be expected to participate in synchronous instruction via zoom technology, and daily attendance will be taken. Specific class schedules will be shared by each grade level teacher at a later date.

- Kindergarten: 2-hour daily learning block, morning session time to be determined.
- 1st-5th Grades: Core instruction blocks occur from approximately 7:50 a.m. to 11:50 am; Electives and Interventions options are available in the afternoon.
- Secondary students to follow A/B daily schedule, which includes 4 classes each day. Specific class times will be communicated by Forreston Jr/Sr High School.

The current grading system will remain in effect for all students. Teachers will be available daily for any questions, individual student conferencing, and/or assessment administration. When possible, priority in-person services will be offered for students with special education needs and secondary students with technology needs. Families who may qualify for these services will be communicated with individually. Free lunches will continue to be offered for all students, with additional details to come.

Thank you for your patience and understanding during these unprecedented times. We will continue to communicate as information is available and will have a decision regarding an adaptive pause to inperson learning after the Thanksgiving break communicated by the end of the week.
